Opportunity: Canoe the Bronx River in a small group with family and Sebago friends

Date: Sunday, June 26th (rain or shine, no rain date)

Skill level required: None!

Boats: This is a canoe only event but open to anyone interested in paddling. Canoes provided by our friends at the Bronx River Alliance

Permission slips: Participants must be ACA members or sign the ACA waiver

Reservations: We have ten canoes that can carry 2-3 people each

Cost: We'll make a donation to the Bronx River Alliance

What to bring: PFD, sun block, bag lunch, water, kneeling pad

What is provided: Canoes, paddles, canoe shuttle service, first aid kit

Trip description

Put in at Shoelace Park (near 219th St in the Bronx), paddle through the Botanical Garden, old growth forest, the Bronx Zoo, portage three dams, take out at Hunts Point Riverside Park.
